20.6.25 7.30pm Celebrity recital - Daniel Moulton at St John's, Sidcup.

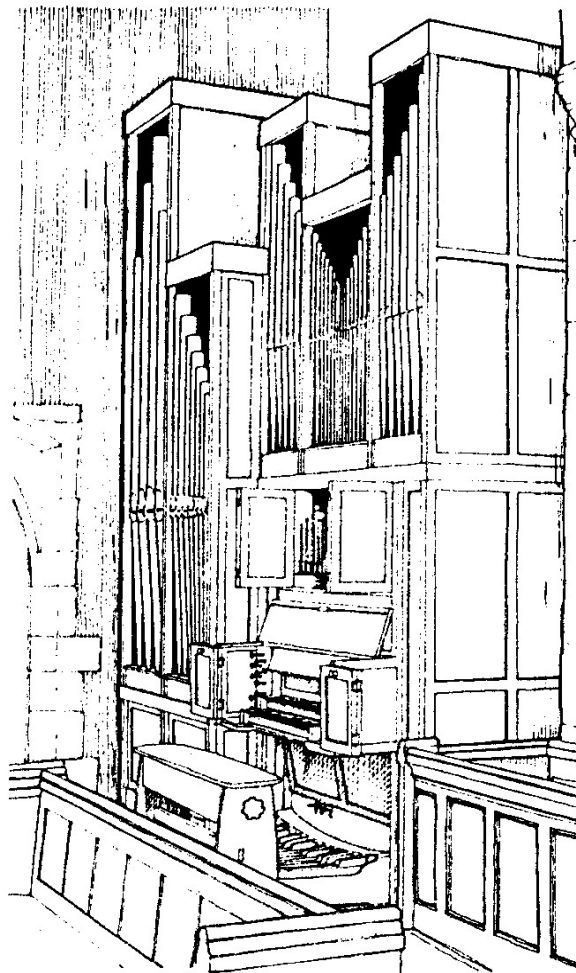

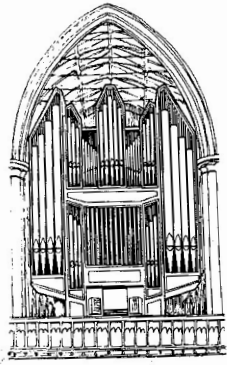
